

Guidelines for the Scenario “Use of media devices in 2020”

The media have dramatically changed within the last couple of years.

20 years ago most people in Europe did not have access to the internet, 10 years ago 50% had access and now there are only about 20% who don't have access to the internet.

Today students say they use facebook, etc. more than email to communicate. Everybody uses mobile phones today, but 10 years ago students explained the use of mobile phones to teachers. ...

Young people have really different media habits concerning TV, radio, mp3-players than their parents' generation.

Most households have got at least one computer now. But: students say that they don't use the computer for internet access so much any more.

Many people use navigation devices instead of an (old-fashioned) map.
